

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO RESUME APPLICATION AND COLLECTION OF THE LOCAL SALES TAX ON THE TITLING OF MOTOR VEHICLES, TRAILERS, BOATS, AND OUTBOARD MOTORS THAT WERE PURCHASED FROM A SOURCE OTHER THAN A LICENSED MISSOURI DEALER.

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WHEREAS, the City under the provisions of Section 32.087 RSMo did submit to the qualified voters of the City at an election held November 3, 2015, the question of repealing the application of the local sales tax to the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer, which the voters disapproved;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 32.087 RSMo, the City Council of Richmond Heights does hereby resume the application of the local sales tax to the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that are subject to state sales tax under section 144.020 and purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer to the voters.

SECTION 2. The local sales tax shall apply to the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall forward to the Director of Revenue of the State of Missouri by United States registered mail or certified mail, a certified copy of this ordinance together with certifications of the election returns and accompanied by a map of the City clearly showing the boundaries thereof.
