

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF LADUE, MISSOURI, OUTLINING THE REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE AND OTHER PROJECT RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE LAY ROAD SIDEWALK AND ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, A PORTION OF WHICH ARE LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the City of Ladue has obtained Federal Funds and is the project sponsor for improvements on Lay Road between Clayton Road and South McKnight Road, including pavement rehabilitation in a project known as STP-5529(612).

WHEREAS, the cities of Ladue and Richmond Heights wish to cooperate with one another to provide improvements on Lay Road as the municipal boundary between the two cities are within the limits of the Lay Road Improvement Project and is located at the approximate centerline of Lay Road from Clayton Road to South McKnight Road; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the signatories to enter into this Agreement to outline how expenditures for Lay Road Improvements within the City of Richmond Heights will be funded and reimbursed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Ladue, attached hereto and incorporated herein, as **Exhibit A** is hereby approved. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute same on behalf of the City, and the Deputy City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest thereto. The documents as executed shall be in substantially the form of **Exhibit A**, with such changes therein as shall be approved by the officers of the City executing same, consistent with the provisions and intent of this Ordinance and necessary, desirable, convenient or proper in order to carry out the matters herein authorized. The City Manager and her designees are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all reasonable actions necessary, desirable, convenient and proper in order to carry out the intent of this Ordinance, the matters herein authorized, and the rights and duties of the City under the Agreement.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately following its passage and being signed as provided by City Charter to allow timely execution of the improvement project as set out with the provisions of the STP Program agreement that the City of Ladue and the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission have executed.
