

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4788, THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI; CHAPTER 600 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: SECTION 600.200 PACKAGE LICENSES - BUSINESS, SUBSECTION A.; BY ADDING NEW BUSINESS ENTITLED TO BE ISSUED LICENSE TO SELL PACKAGED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; 'HOTEL LOBBY MARKET', IN THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI..

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4788, the Municipal Code of the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri, Chapter 600; Alcoholic Beverages, Section 600.200 Package Licenses-Business, subsection A., is hereby amended by adding new business allowed to sell packaged alcoholic beverages and is hereby enacted to read as follows:

CHAPTER 600. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

SECTION 600.200 -PACKAGE LICENSES-BUSINESS

A. No license permitting the sale of intoxicating liquor or non-intoxicating beer in the original package for consumption off the premises where sold shall be issued except to a person engaged in one (1) or more of the following businesses: drugstore, cigar and tobacco store, grocery store, general merchandise store or delicatessen store [**ADD NEW hotel lobby market**]; nor to any such person who does not have and keep in his/her store a stock of goods having a value according to invoices of at least five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), exclusive of fixtures and intoxicating and non-intoxicating beer; nor to any such person who does not have a merchant's license from the City.

All other Sections remain the same.


SECTION 2. The Chapter, Article, Division and/or Section assignments designated in this Ordinance may be revised and altered in the process of re-codifying or servicing the City's Code of Ordinances upon supplementation of such code if, in the discretion of the editor, an alternative designation would be more reasonable. In adjusting such designations the editor may also change other designations and numerical assignment of code sections to accommodate such changes.

SECTION 3. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that each and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, section and subsection hereof and that the City Council intends to adopt each said part, section and subsection separately and independently of any other part, section and subsection. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been

unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections and subsections shall be and remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 31st day after its passage as provided by law.


