

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 4810, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A NEW AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI AND THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD, MISSOURI FOR RECREATIONAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, in order to enhance the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Brentwood, Missouri and the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri, the parties desired to provide a partnership for parks and recreation services with the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri, approved Ordinance No. 4810 on January 22, 2002, authorizing an agreement for recreation services between the City of Richmond Heights and the City of Brentwood, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights wishes to enter into a new agreement with the City of Brentwood, Missouri in order to continue to promote cooperation and provide recreational activities for the City of Brentwood residents.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4810, passed and signed, January 22, 2002 is hereby rescinded.

SECTION 2. The City of Richmond Heights, Missouri is hereby authorized to enter into a new agreement for recreation services with the City of Brentwood, Missouri.

SECTION 3. The Mayor of the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City and the Clerk of the City of Richmond Heights is hereby authorized to attest and to affix thereto the Official Seal of the City to an agreement for recreation services with the City of Brentwood, Missouri.

SECTION 4. The agreement authorized for execution and attestation shall be substantially in the form and contain the words as per Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance by reference.

SECTION 5. A copy of the fully executed contract may be filed with the Office of the Secretary of State of Missouri and in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of St. Louis County.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on the thirty-first day following its passage and being signed as provided by law.
