

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF ANNUAL TAXES FOR THE POLICE AND FIREMEN RETIREMENT FUND TO BE COLLECTED IN THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI FOR THE YEAR 2010.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Richmond Heights in accord with the provisions of Section 137.073.5(3) and (4), RSMo. Supp. 2008, hereby raises the tax rate ceiling for all tax levies assessed for the Police and Firemen Retirement Fund to the prior year tax rate ceiling allowable prior to the voluntary reduction.

SECTION 2. There is hereby levied upon all residential real estate property subject to taxation for such purposes in the City of Richmond Heights, a tax for the Police and Firemen Retirement Fund for the year 2010 of TWENTY-NINE CENTS (\$.290) per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation.

SECTION 3. There is hereby levied upon all commercial real estate property subject to taxation for such purposes in the City of Richmond Heights, a tax for the Police and Firemen Retirement Fund for the year 2010 of THIRTY-TWO AND NINE TENTHS CENTS (\$.329) per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation.

SECTION 4. There is hereby levied upon all personal property subject to taxation for such purposes in the City of Richmond Heights, a tax for the Police and Firemen Retirement Fund for the year 2010 of THIRTY-TWO CENTS (\$.320) per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately following its passage and being signed as provided by law.
