

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4788, THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, BY AMENDING SUBSECTION 110.060 B, REGARDING THE FOUR CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS, the 2010 Census results have been reviewed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intent of the City Council to amend the City Council District boundaries to comply with the Charter of the City of Richmond Heights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Code of the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri, is hereby amended by deleting Subsection B of Section 110.060 and inserting in lieu thereof a new Subsection B, to read as follows:

B. The City of Richmond Heights is hereby divided into the following four (4) districts:

1. *District 1 – North Zone*

The area contained within the following boundaries: starting at the intersections of the northern City Limits and the centerline of Surrey Hills Drive; then southwardly along the centerline of Surrey Hills Drive to the intersection with Wise Avenue; then southwardly along the centerline of Wise Avenue, to Laclede Station road; then southwardly down the center line of Laclede Station road to Interstate 64; then eastwardly along the center of Interstate 64 to the centerline of Claytonia Terrace; then southwardly along the centerline of Claytonia Terrace to Dale Avenue; then eastwardly along the centerline of Dale to Big Bend Boulevard; then northwardly along the centerline of Big Bend Boulevard to Interstate 64; then eastwardly along the centerline of Interstate 64 to Sunset Avenue; then northwardly along the centerline of Sunset Avenue to Wise Avenue; then westwardly along the centerline of Wise Avenue to Highland Terrace; then northwardly on the centerline of Highland Terrace to Ethel Avenue; then westwardly on the centerline of Ethel Avenue to Big Bend Boulevard; then northwardly along the centerline of Big Bend Boulevard to Clayton Road; then westwardly along the centerline of Clayton Road to the point of beginning.

2. *District 2 – South Zone*

The area contained within the following boundaries: starting at the intersection of the southern City Limits and the centerline of Hanley Road; then northwardly along the centerline of Hanley Road to Interstate 64; then eastwardly on Interstate 64 to the centerline of Claytonia terrace; then southwardly along the centerline of Claytonia Terrace to the centerline of Dale avenue; the eastwardly along the centerline of Dale avenue to the centerline of Big Bend Boulevard; then southwardly along the centerline of Big Bend Boulevard to Arlington Drive; then eastwardly along the centerline of Arlington Drive to Del Norte Avenue; then southwardly along the centerline of Del Norte Avenue to the southern City Limits; then westwardly along the southern City Limits to Big Bend Boulevard; then northwardly along the centerline of Big Bend Boulevard to West Bruno; then westwardly along the centerline of West Bruno to the point of beginning.

3. *District 3 – East Zone*

All of the area east of the eastern boundaries of District One (1) and Two (2) to the eastern City Limits.

4. *District 4 – West Zone*

All of the areas west of the western boundary of District One (1) to the western City Limits.

SECTION 2. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that each and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, section and subsection hereof and that the City Council intends to adopt each said part, section and subsection separately and independently of any other part, section and subsection. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections and subsections shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately following its passage and being signed as provided by law.
