

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS AS DULY ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, as duly elected officials of the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri, the Mayor and the City Council members are specifically directed to perform certain duties and obligations as imposed by the Charter of the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, in performance of these duties and obligations, the Mayor and City Council members may meet and attend regular or special sessions of the Council and are currently compensated for attendance at these sessions; and

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri provides that Council may from time to time determine the compensation of the Mayor and Council members by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the compensation rate of the Mayor and Council Members was last changed in 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The compensation rate set for the Mayor shall change and commence with the term of the mayor elected at the next regular city election held at least six (6) months after the approval of this Ordinance and the compensation rate set for City Council Members shall change and commence with the terms of the council members elected at the second regular city election held after the approval of this Ordinance (municipal general election date in April, 2016) as follows:

City Council Members

Compensation per month: \$480.00

Mayor

Additional Compensation: \$6,000 annually

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately

following its passage and being signed as provided by law.
