

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A NON-BINDING BALLOT PROPOSITION REGARDING TRUCK PARKING ON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, AND CALLING FOR AN ELECTION ON SUCH PROPOSITION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2008.

WHEREAS, for many years the City of Richmond Heights has prohibited the parking of trucks on the public streets of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has continually heard both favorable and unfavorable comments regarding this law; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to provide all voters of Richmond Heights the opportunity to address this issue in order to provide the Council guidance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. An election is hereby called to submit to voters of the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri, at an election to be held November 4, 2008, a non-binding proposition to allow truck parking on the public streets of the City of Richmond Heights.

SECTION 2. The ballot question shall read as follows:

"Shall the City Council consider legislation that would allow a light duty passenger truck with no commercial designation to park on the City of Richmond Heights streets while continuing to not allow commercial trucks to do so?"

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force following its passage and being signed as provided by law.
