

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR PROVIDING CONVEYANCE OF PRISONERS SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITIES OF WEBSTER GROVES AND RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Mayor of the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri, is authorized to execute on behalf of the City, an intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement for providing conveyance of prisoners services with the City of Webster Groves, Missouri, in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest such signature and to attach the official seal of the City of Richmond Heights to said Agreement.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 31st day from and after its passage by the City Council.

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR PRISONER
CONVEYANCE**

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into on the effective date hereinafter set forth, by and between signatories hereto (and also those which may hereafter become signatory hereto):

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, a coordinated approach to prisoner conveyance is desired for certain municipalities in St. Louis County, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, such approach can be of great value to the municipalities, the signatories hereto; and

WHEREAS, Chapters 70 and 321 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri authorize joint exercise by two or more local governments of any power common to them; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the signatories hereto to provide for and maintain a joint prisoner conveyance for their mutual advantage and concern.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises, the mutual advantages to be derived therefrom and in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. Cooperative Agency Established. Pursuant to the joint powers authorization of Chapters 70 and 321 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, the undersigned do hereby enter into a cooperative agreement for prisoner conveyance, which shall consist of all of the parties that become signatory hereto.

2. Each party shall contribute toward the cost of prisoner conveyance, in cash or in contribution of manpower and machinery as shall be acceptable to all parties. Any cash contributions shall be deposited in escrow by the City of Richmond Heights and shall be disbursed upon authorization of a majority of the members present and voting to do so at a duly

called meeting. Contributions shall be as follows: Richmond Heights – One Van and Two Officers; Webster Groves – One Van and One Officer. These contributions will be reviewed and revised annually by mutual consent of the cities that are members, which consent shall be deemed given by each city if that city appropriates funds in its budget for the respective contribution from each city.

3. Participation. Each participating unit of government (and each local unit that may hereafter sign) is entitled to the rights and privileges and subject to the obligations of this Agreement.

4. Withdrawal. Any party to this Agreement may cease to be a party hereto and may withdraw from participation upon thirty days notice.

5. Powers. A Steering Committee shall exercise the powers hereunder, which shall be composed of a representative from each participating entity.

6. Amendments. This Agreement may not be amended, except by written agreement and resolution of all the then parties to it.

7. Duration. Subject to Section 4, this Agreement shall continue in effect until rescinded by unanimous consent of the then parties. Upon such termination, any assets remaining shall be returned to the signatories.

8. Enforcement. Each member shall have the right to enforce this Agreement against any other members.

9. Authorization. Prior to execution of this Agreement, each member shall deliver to the other a certified copy of a suitable ordinance or resolution authorizing and directing the execution of this Agreement.

10. Effective Date. This Agreement shall become effective when signed by all of the respective representatives of the Cities of Richmond Heights and Webster Groves each in St. Louis County, Missouri.
