

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4788, THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, CHAPTER 330, SEC. 330.030, SCHEDULE XIII, STOP INTERSECTIONS AND LOCATIONS; BY PLACING STOP SIGNS ON BANNEKER AVENUE FOR SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC AT ELINOR AVENUE, AND DALE AVENUE FOR TRAFFIC EASTBOUND AND WESTBOUND AT INTERSECTIONS OF CLAYTONIA TERRACE, BREDELL AVENUE AND LACLEDE STATION ROAD; AMENDING SECTION 350 PARKING REGULATIONS, SECTION 350.050 BY ADDING (A.) AND (B.); AND ADDING NEW SCHEDULE XVIII, DEDICATED BIKE LANES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS, MISSOURI as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4788, the Municipal Code of the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri, is hereby amended by amending Section 330.030, Schedule XIII, Stop Intersections and Locations Table XIII-A; to include the following language:

<u>Intersection or Location</u>	<u>Traffic on Street, Highway or Alley Listed Below Shall Stop</u>
Banneker Avenue and Elinor Avenue	Southbound traffic on Banneker Avenue
Dale Avenue and Bredell Avenue	Northbound traffic on Bredell Avenue; eastbound and westbound traffic on Dale Avenue
Dale Avenue and Claytonia Terrace	Northbound and southbound traffic on Claytonia Terrace; eastbound and westbound traffic on Dale Avenue
Dale Avenue and Laclede Station Road	Northbound and southbound traffic on Laclede Station Road; eastbound and westbound traffic on Dale Avenue

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4788, the Municipal Code of the City of Richmond Heights, Missouri, SECTION 350 PARKING REGULATIONS, Section 350.050 is hereby amended to include the following language:

- A. When signs are erected or when adjacent curbing has been painted yellow giving notice, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule IV.

- B. When signs are erected or when a dedicated bike lane is enclosed by solid white lane markings, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon a dedicated bike lane described in Schedule XVIII.

SECTION 3. Creates new **Schedule XVIII, DEDICATED BIKE LANES**

**Table XVIII-A.** Bike lanes are hereby established at the following locations:

**Location**

Dale Avenue – North and south sides between Laclede Station Road and Big Bend Boulevard

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that each and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, section and subsection hereof and that the City Council intends to adopt each said part, section and subsection separately and independently of any other part, section and subsection. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections and subsections shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 31<sup>st</sup> day after its passage as provided by law.
