- One round-trip per day (*to & from*)
- Please cancel your rides at least 24 hours in advance
- No food or drink on the bus
- We provide a curb to curb service. If you will have an aide, let us know when you call
- Please be ready 15 minutes prior to your requested pick up times. Driver can only wait a short time in order to stay on schedule. We ask that you wait where you can see the bus as it arrives
- You must provide the address of your destination when calling
- For inclement weather, when MRH School is closed, the Van Service will be as well
