Van Service Rules

- One round-trip per day (to & from).
- We ask that you please cancel your rides at least 24 hours in advance.
- No food or drink on the bus.
- We provide a curb to curb service. If you will have an aide, let us know when you call.
- You must be on time and ready to go at your scheduled pick up time. Driver will wait no longer than 5 minutes; they will honk and call you. We ask that you wait where you can see the bus as it arrives.
- You must provide the address of your destination when calling.
- For inclement weather, when MRH School is closed, the Van Service will be as well.
- Last pick-up is at 1:30 p.m. and last return home is 2:30 p.m. Exceptions for Dr. Appointments, 2-2:30 p.m., but with no way home.
